

CPI Leadership Signature Course 2023

Dear all,

To succeed as a radiology leader today, skills beyond diagnosing images accurately and efficiently are needed. The goal of this workshop is to help you better understand your leadership capabilities and how you can make an impact in the world around yourself by capitalizing on them. At the end of the course you should be able to answer the following questions:

“What type of leader am I?”

“What type of leader do I want to be, and how can I achieve this?”

“What is the best way for me to tell my leadership story?”

“How can I use the crucibles of my life to become an inspirational leader?”

We will conduct exercises and one-to-one online interactions with the focus on how you can further develop as a leader. For this we will walk through your “immunities to change” discussing how you could overcome them by using family systems, developmental and personality psychology and organizational change tools.

The course contains a combination of cases, discussion of papers (as a background), exercises, storytelling and most notably, reflection. We will not discuss radiology cases in this workshop but the discussions of this workshop can leverage yourself to become a better leader in your field of interest, in this case, radiology.

Learning Objectives:

1. Assess individual leadership signatures: how they were developed ("Child of the Past"), where they stand now ("Developed Self"), and how they can be enhanced ("Future Self").
2. Develop your own leadership stories.
3. Learn from leadership experiences of others.
4. Create and enact a plan for positive change and local/global impact.

Impact:

Improve your self-knowledge in order to become a more compelling leader, engage in activities that focus on your strengths and increase the level of trust and mutual comprehension in a team (both at the team player and team leader levels).
