Diagnostic Radiology Chest

Transition to Discipline (TTD) constitutes your PGY1 (13 blocks). Residents should aim to log a minimum of 2 EPAs per week.

The following are the EPA's you should focus on when on Chest:

- TTD-1 (2 required in TTD, minimum of 1-2 on this rotation)
- TTD-2 (1 required in TTD, minimum of 1 on this rotation)
- TTD-3 (7 required in TTD, minimum of 1-5 on this rotation)
- TTD-6 (3 required in TTD)
- FOD-1 (12 required in FOD)
- FOD-4 (10 required in FOD)
- FOD-5 (20 required in FOD)
- FOD-8 (12 required in FOD)

How to Complete an EPA:

- 1. Login to Elentra, initiate the EPA and provide the assessment demographics. This can be done on your mobile phone or computer.
- 2. Complete the assessment scale for each dimension.
- 3. Using the global entrustment scale below, decide whether the resident can be entrusted (Competent and Proficient) overall to perform this activity with a similar case in the future. In general, residents are not expected to be entrustable early in a new stage of training.
- 4. Discuss feedback and attain coaching tips.
