

Department of Medical Imaging Academic Productivity Resident Award

Background

The University of Toronto's Department of Medical Imaging is committed to fostering research and academic productivity among residents. This award was developed to encourage, support and motivate academic productivity among residents. The inaugural award will launch on December 15, 2024 with proposals due on March 1, 2025.

Award

- \$1000 prize for one resident
- The eligibility period runs January 1, 2024 – December 31, 2024

Eligibility

- Applicants must:
 - a) Be a diagnostic radiology resident at the University of Toronto Department of Medical Imaging in the 2023/2024 academic year
- The award will be based on academic productivity in the 2024 calendar year, determined by:
 - b) Peer-reviewed manuscripts published in 2024 with weighting based on author position and journal impact factor
 - c) Other considerations will include non-peer reviewed manuscripts, scientific presentations, grants, and research awards
- Residents are only eligible to win the award once

Application Process

- December 15, 2024 – Call for applications posted
- March 1, 2025, 5pm ET – Deadline for applications
- End-March 2025 – Notification of award winner

Applications

- Academic productivity summary only including items published or received in the 2024 calendar year, maximum 1 page:
 - a) Peer reviewed publications, include full citation and author list
 - b) Non-peer reviewed publications, include full citation and author list
 - c) Scientific presentations, including format (poster, oral presentation), meeting name and location
 - d) Grants, including role, funding agency, and amount
 - e) Research awards
- Academic productivity peer reviewed publication excel template, with information on each peer reviewed publication on a separate line
- All documents should be saved with file names starting with the applicants first and last name and sent as attachments by email to medical.imaging@utoronto.ca with subject line "**Academic Productivity Resident Award**".

Selection Committee

Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee appointed by the department Chair and Vice Chair, research.
