

# TTD-5 Assessing patients with common medical or surgical presentations

Transition to Discipline (TTD) constitutes your PGY1 (13 blocks). Residents should aim to log a minimum of 2 EPAs per week.

#### Criteria:

- 1. Residents are responsible for completing a minimum of 7 (-seven) TTD5 EPA's.
- Residents should aim to complete 7 (-seven) entrustable TTD5 over the course of the rotations listed below (mandatory minimum of 1 for Cardiology, Emergency Medicine, General Surgery, Internal Medicine, Respirology, Paediatrics).
  - a. A minimum of 2 (-two) entrustable EPA's must be Medical Presentations
  - b. A minimum of 2 (-two) entrustable EPA's must be Surgical Presentations.
- 3. To be completed by a faculty member, fellow, or senior resident.

### Dimensions:

- 1. This EPA includes performing a clinic al assessment, including history and physical exam, developing a differential diagnosis, and selecting and prioritizing laboratory and imaging investigations.
- 2. This EPA will be observed in the ambulatory, emergency department or inpatient setting, with adult and pediatric patients, in a range of clinical conditions.

## Rotations to Complete this EPA include:

- Cardiology (1 required)
- Emergency Medicine (1 required)
- General Surgery (1 required)
- Internal Medicine (1 required)
- Neurology
- Obstetrical Medicine & Gynecology
- Orthopedic Surgery
- Paediatrics (1 required)
- Respirology (1 required)
- Urology

#### How to Complete an EPA:

- 1. Login to Elentra, initiate the EPA and provide the assessment demographics. This can be done on your mobile phone or computer.
- 2. Complete the assessment scale for each dimension.
- 3. Using the global entrustment scale below, decide whether the resident can be entrusted (Competent and Proficient) overall to perform this activity with a similar case in the future. In general, residents are not expected to be entrustable early in a new stage of training.
- 4. Discuss feedback and attain coaching tips.
