

TTD-6 Working effectively as a member of the interprofessional team

Transition to Discipline (TTD) constitutes your PGY1 (13 blocks). Residents should aim to log a minimum of 2 EPAs per week.

Criteria:

- 1. Residents are responsible for completing a minimum of 3 (-three) TTD6 EPA's.
- 2. Residents should aim to complete 3 (-three) entrustable TTD6 per each of the rotations listed below.
- 3. To be completed by staff radiologist, other faculty member, fellow, senior resident, or allied health professional.
 - a. A minimum of 2 (-two) entrustable EPA's must be completed based on input from nurses or allied health professionals.

Dimensions:

- 1. This EPA focuses on accessing and using information systems to gather clinical data from the patient's chart and the image storage system (e.g., PACS).
- This includes summarizing the history, pertinent physical examination findings and results of relevant investigations from the clinical record and retrieving the imaging study and pertinent priors for review with a supervisor.
- 3. This EPA may be observed in patients undergoing any medical imaging study; the observation of this EPA is based on a single case.
- 4. This EPA does not include the use of advanced PACS functions—that is a Foundation stage activity.

Rotations to Complete this EPA include:

- Introduction to Diagnostic Radiology: Chest Imaging
- Introduction to Diagnostic Radiology: Computed Tomography

How to Complete an EPA:

- 1. Login to Elentra, initiate the EPA and provide the assessment demographics. This can be done on your mobile phone or computer.
- 2. Complete the assessment scale for each dimension.
- 3. Using the global entrustment scale below, decide whether the resident can be entrusted (Competent and Proficient) overall to perform this activity with a similar case in the future. In general, residents are not expected to be entrustable early in a new stage of training.
- 4. Discuss feedback and attain coaching tips.
